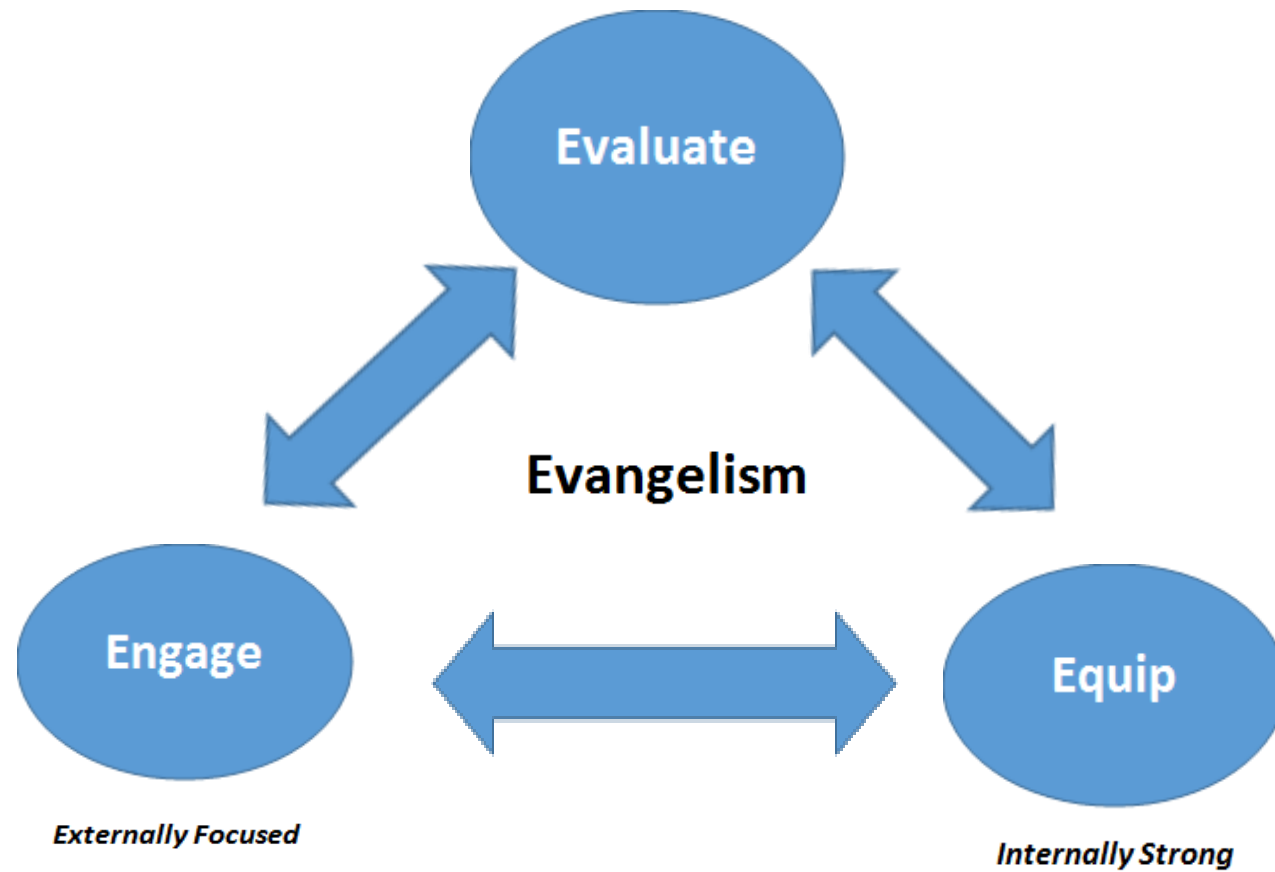
Vision Statement

μεταδίδωμι mētadidōmi, (met-ad-id'-o-mee); to give over, i.e. share:—give, impart

This giving is the distribution of one's own goods, not to be confused with the alms of the church (benevolence).

Why are we challenged in our giving?

Giving

It is not just that you give, but the manner in which you give matters.

Generously

ἀπλότης **haplōtēs**, (*hap-lot'-ace*); **(subj.) sincerity (without dissimulation or self-seeking), or generosity—bountifulness, liberal** (-ity), simplicity, singleness.

Giving Generously

“ while *you are* enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God. ¹² For the administration of this service not only supplies the needs of the saints, but also is abounding through many thanksgivings to God, ¹³ while, through the proof of this ministry, they glorify God for the obedience of your confession to the gospel of Christ, and for *your liberal sharing with them and all men,,*”

II Corinthians 9:11-13

Giving Generously

The one **who gives** should give with **liberality**, both sincerely and sacrificially. Believers ought to be generous in funding the work of God (cf. Matt 6:21; 2 Cor 9:6–7; Gal 6:6–10).
